### Transport

Suffolk County Council run a network of transport to serve the sixth form centres and colleges.

Students will need to opt in for this service at: <a href="www.suffolkonboard.com">www.suffolkonboard.com</a>.

Applications need to be made from 1st March - 31st May 2023.

Cost of £320 per term currently. (Subsidies are available for SEND and Pupil Premium students).


