

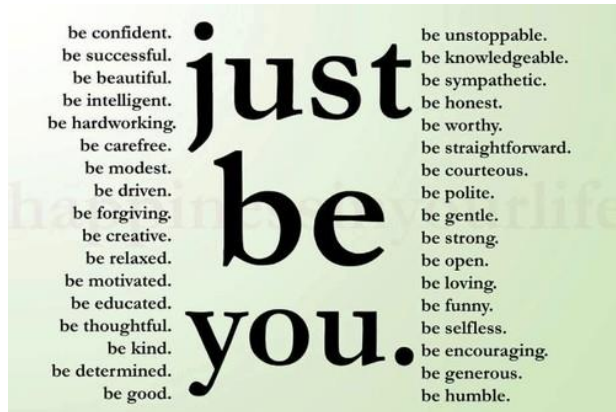
Monday 9 January
