

## **Debenham High School – COVID-19 Catch up Funding**

Funding received in 2020-21 was £53,440 of which £6207 was spent in 2020-21. We identify need by considering a range of inputs, teacher identification, analysis of data and student perception surveys, and this will be continually assessed as further areas for attention may become apparent as the student progresses through their education.

We have a range of intervention strategies in place or planned for students in any year group, as appropriate:

- Year 7 development of skills and learning that may have been compromised due to lost learning time in primary settings
- Year 6 outreach transition work to improve knowledge and skills, by offering sessions in primary schools, and providing resources to support
- Pastoral intervention and support for students in Years 7-11 with identified need, focussing on engagement in lessons, behaviour and mental health
- Provision of whole school resources, which may include online, subject specific resources
- Provision of tutoring for disadvantaged or underachieving students, using school staff or external providers as appropriate

The programme is planned to continue throughout the next two academic years as new needs become apparent throughout the students' education at Debenham High School, and will run in conjunction with, and support, the activities under the Recovery and National Tutoring Programmes.

Impact is assessed through analysis of attainment and progress data, student feedback, monitoring of learning behaviour, attendance at out of hours sessions, and monitoring behaviours and skills of new cohorts.
