Grade Summary

Headline figures for 2021:

- 129 students sat 1,132 GCSE Examinations (or an equivalent vocational qualification).
- 94% of our students achieved a Grade 4 or higher in both English and Mathematics.
- 83% of our students achieved a Grade 5 or higher in both English and Mathematics.
- 44% of our students' results were Grade 7 or higher, or equivalent (Grade D*2).
